**TITLE:** ADOPTION OF LOCAL LAW, INTRO. NO. 12 - 78, PRINT NO. 1, ESTABLISHING THE ANNUAL SALARY FOR THE ALLEGANY COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ELECTIONS

RESOLVED:

- 1. That proposed Local Law, Intro. No. 12 - 78, Print No. 1, is hereby adopted without any change in language, to wit:

A LOCAL LAW ESTABLISHING THE ANNUAL SALARY FOR THE ALLEGANY COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ELECTIONS

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Legislators of the County of Allegany as follows:

Section 1. The annual salary of each incumbent of the office of the Allegany County Commissioner of Elections, excluding any earned longevity increment which the incumbent of such office may be entitled to, shall be the sum of \$4,250.

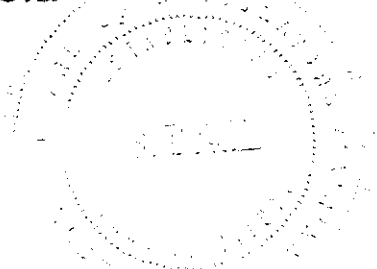
§ 2. This local law shall take effect on January 1, 1979; provided, however, that in the event this local law is filed in the office of the Secretary of State after January 1, 1979, then, in such event, this local law shall take effect on the date of such filing.
