TITLE: ADOPTION OF LOCAL LAW INTRO. NO. 1 - 80, PRINT NO. 1, TO AMEND LOCAL LAW NUMBER FOUR OF NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE ENTITLED "A LOCAL LAW TO PROVIDE FOR A PARTIAL TAX EXEMPTION OF REAL PROPERTY OWNED BY CERTAIN PERSONS WITH LIMITED INCOME WHO ARE SIXTY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE OR OVER", IN RELATION TO INCOME ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT

RESOLVED:

- 1. That proposed Local Law, Intro. No. 1-80, Print No. 1, is hereby adopted without any change in language, to wit:

A LOCAL LAW TO AMEND LOCAL LAW NUMBER FOUR OF NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE, ENTITLED "A LOCAL LAW TO PROVIDE FOR A PARTIAL TAX EXEMPTION OF REAL PROPERTY OWNED BY CERTAIN PERSONS WITH LIMITED INCOME WHO ARE SIXTY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE OR OVER", IN RELATION TO INCOME ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT

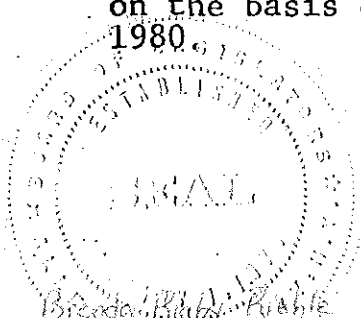
BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Legislators of the County of Allegheny as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision b. of section two of local law number four of nineteen hundred seventy-one, as last amended by local law number two of nineteen hundred and seventy-seven, is hereby amended to read as follows:

b. The income of the owner or the combined income of the owners or the combined income of husband and wife where title is vested in either the husband or wife must not exceed six thousand dollars for the income tax year immediately preceding the date that the application is filed.

§ 2. This local law shall take effect immediately and shall apply to assessment rolls used for county real property taxes and prepared on the basis of taxable status dates occurring on or after April 1, 1980.
