TITLE: ADOPTION OF LOCAL LAW INTRO. NO. 1-82, PRINT NO. 1, TO ESTABLISH ANNUAL SERVICE INCREMENTS FOR COUNTY OFFICERS APPOINTED FOR A FIXED TERM AND COUNTY CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICERS AND TERMINATE THE EFFECT OF PREVIOUS LOCAL LAWS GRANTING DIFFERENT INCREMENTS

RESOLVED:

- 1. That proposed Local Law, Intro. No. 1-82, Print No. 1, is hereby adopted without any change in language, to wit:

A LOCAL LAW TO ESTABLISH ANNUAL SERVICE INCREMENTS FOR COUNTY OFFICERS APPOINTED FOR A FIXED TERM AND COUNTY CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICERS; TERMINATING EFFECT OF PREVIOUS LOCAL LAWS GRANTING DIFFERENT INCREMENTS

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Legislators of the County of Allegany as follows:

Section 1. Each county officer appointed for a fixed term who has completed before or on July 1, 1982, or who thereafter completes the years of continuous county service set forth below, shall receive on an annual basis commencing on July 1, 1982 if such completion date falls before or on July 1, 1982 or commencing on such completion date if such completion date falls on a date subsequent to July 1, 1982 and continuing, in either event, until such officer no longer occupies such appointed office, the noncumulative amount established below that applies to the years of continuous service which such officer has completed, to wit:

a. Each officer who is entitled to receive any of the above amounts on July 1, 1982 shall receive such applicable amount in twenty-six equal or near equal biweekly installments commencing with the pay date of July 15, 1982.

b. Each officer who becomes entitled to receive any of the above amounts subsequent to July 1, 1982 shall receive such applicable amount in twenty-six equal or near equal installments

commencing with the first pay date subsequent to such entitlement date.

§ 2. Each county constitutional officer who at the commencement of his term of office which commences after the effective date of this local law or who during any term of office which commences after the effective date of this local law will have completed the years of continuous county service set forth in section one of this local law, shall receive on an annual basis commencing on the commencement date of such term of office or on such completion date if such date falls within such term of office and continuing until such officer no longer occupies such constitutional office, the noncumulative amount set forth in section one of this local law that applies to the years of continuous county service which such officer has completed.

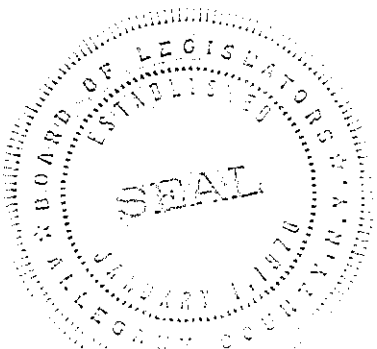
§ 3. Each county officer appointed for a fixed term who has completed before or on July 1, 1982 the years of continuous county service set forth below, shall receive, in addition to the annual amount to which such county officer may be entitled to pursuant to section one of this local law, the amount established below that applies to the years of continuous service which such county officer has completed before or on July 1, 1982, to wit:

<u>Years of Service</u>	<u>Amount</u>
10 to 15	\$ .50
15 to 20	.50
20 to 25	150
25 or more	250

a. Any one of the foregoing amounts which such county officer may be entitled to shall be paid to such officer in a lump sum on the pay date of July 15, 1982.

§ 4. Local law number one of nineteen hundred seventy-two, local law number six of nineteen hundred seventy-four, local law number one of nineteen hundred seventy-eight and local law number nine of nineteen hundred seventy-nine shall no longer be in effect after July 1, 1982, except that such local laws shall remain in effect for any county constitutional officer currently receiving the increments pursuant to such local laws until such officer receives the amount granted under section two of this local law.

§ 5. This local law shall take effect on July 1, 1982.
