## RESOLVED:

1. That proposed Local Law, Intro. No. 3-84, Print No. 1, is hereby adopted without any change in language, to wit:

A LOCAL LAW TO AMEND LOCAL LAW NUMBER TWO OF NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE, IN RELATION TO DEFINING THE TERM PUBLIC HEALTH ADMINISTRATOR

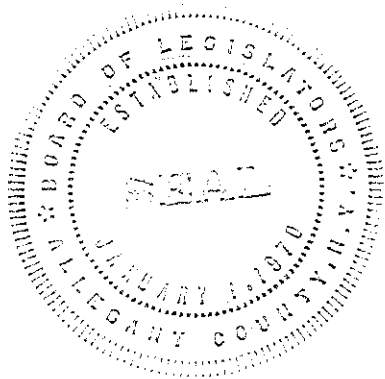
BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Legislators of the County of Allegany as follows:

Section 1. Sections three, four, five, six, seven, eight, nine, ten, eleven and twelve of local law number two of nineteen hundred seventy-five are renumbered four, five, six, seven, eight, nine, ten, eleven, twelve, thirteen and a new section three is added to read as follows:

Section 3. Definitions. Whenever used in this local law, unless otherwise expressly stated or unless the context or subject matter requires a different meaning, the following terms shall have the respective meanings hereinafter set forth or indicated:

(a) public health administrator. The term "public health administrator" means any person who has been or is now appointed to the position of public health administrator or public health director, as such positions were constituted by law on and after the first day of January, nineteen hundred seventy-five, or any person who now or hereafter may be appointed to such position of public health director or be appointed to a position, whatever the title of such position may be, that is given the authority by law to administer and manage, after appropriate medical consultation, the public health programs within the county of Allegany through the county department of health.

Section 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
