**TITLE:** ADOPTION OF LOCAL LAW INTRO. NO. 3 - 78, PRINT NO. 1, TO PROVIDE AN ALTERNATE METHOD FOR COLLECTION OF DELINQUENT VILLAGE TAXES PURSUANT TO SECTION ONE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED FORTY-TWO OF THE REAL PROPERTY TAX LAW

RESOLVED:

- 1. That proposed Local Law, Intro. No. 3 - 78, Print No. 1, is hereby adopted without any change in language, to wit:

A LOCAL LAW TO PROVIDE AN ALTERNATE METHOD FOR COLLECTION OF DELINQUENT VILLAGE TAXES PURSUANT TO SECTION ONE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED FORTY-TWO OF THE REAL PROPERTY TAX LAW

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Legislators of the County of Allegany as follows:

Section 1. Each village within the county of Allegany may provide for the collection of its delinquent village taxes by the county of Allegany pursuant to the provisions of section one thousand four hundred forty-two of the New York Real Property Tax Law provided such collection is requested of the county of Allegany by resolution of the board of trustees of such village and such resolution is filed with the clerk of the Allegany county board of legislators.

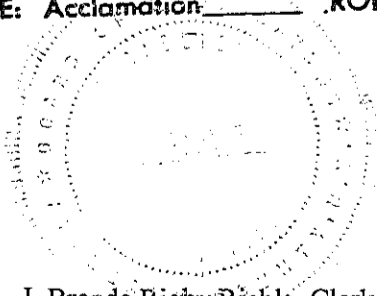
§ 2. This local law shall take effect on the date it is filed in the office of the Secretary of State.
