

NOTICE OF EIGHT-YEAR REVIEW OF ALLEGANY COUNTY AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT NUMBER ONE CREATED WITHIN THE TOWNS OF ALLEN, GROVE, BIRDSALL, HUME, CANEADEA, NEW HUDSON, CENTERVILLE, RUSHFORD, AND GRANGER

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that a periodic review of Allegany County Agricultural District Number One created within the Towns of Allen, Grove, Birdsall, Hume, Caneadea, New Hudson, Centerville, Rushford, and Granger in the County of Allegany on April 5, 1976, and subsequently modified and continued on April 5, 2016, by Resolution No. 287-15, is being conducted by the Allegany County Board of Legislators pursuant to Article 25-AA of the Agriculture and Markets Law of the State of New York.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that such District was formed and is found within the Towns of Allen, Grove, Birdsall, Hume, Caneadea, New Hudson, Centerville, Rushford, and Granger and that such District has a total area of 55,203.68 acres of land.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that a map of such District is on file and open to public inspection in the Allegany County Clerk's Office, 7 Court Street, Belmont, New York 14813.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that any municipality in which such District is found, any landowner within such District may propose a modification of such District.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that any proposed modification of such District must be filed with the Allegany County Clerk at the above address or the Clerk of the County Board of Legislators, 7 Court Street, County Office Building, Belmont, New York 14813, within thirty (30) days after the date of publication of this Notice in *The Spectator* and *Alfred Sun*.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that at the termination of the thirty (30) day period following the publication of this Notice in *The Spectator* and *Alfred Sun*, such District and any such proposed modifications thereof, will be submitted to the Allegany County Planning Board and the Allegany County Agricultural and Farmland Protection Board for review and recommendations, and that thereafter a public hearing will be held on such District, proposed modifications, and the recommendations of such Boards.
