


What is naloxone and how does it work?

- It reverses opioid overdoses and is effective even against highly potent synthetic opioids, like fentanyl!
- It is easy to administer and safe to use on any person who may have experienced an opioid overdose, including adults, adolescents, children (even infants), older adults, pregnant persons, and animals
- It has no medication-substance interactions, except with opioids

The next time you see someone experiencing an overdose, remember the **A.N.C.H.O.R.** steps:

- A**ssess the individual
- N**aloxone Administration
- C**all 911
- H**ave additional naloxone ready
- O**bserve and provide rescue breathing
- R**eview and monitor the individual's condition

To use intranasal naloxone, simply **Peel, Place and Press.**
