**For Immediate Release: ALLEGANY COUNTY, N.Y. INVITES REBIDS, SOLICITING BIDS FOR THE SUPPLY OF LIQUEFIED PETROLEUM GAS (LPG) AND A SELF-CONTAINED PORTABLE DISPENSING STATION FOR THE COUNTY'S PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION**

**Belmont, N.Y.** - Allegany County is soliciting bids for competitive pricing for the supply of liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) and a self-contained portable dispensing station for the County's public transportation system. Initially, Allegany County will be fueling two (2) Ford E-450 Dual Rear Wheel Cutaway 16 Passenger (14A/2WC) buses with the option to add five (5) additional buses in the future. Future plans could include a second self-contained portable dispensing station for a second location. The location for the initial self-contained portable dispensing station is 31 S. Branch Road, Friendship, New York. Allegany County is requesting bids for a turnkey system that includes all equipment, maintenance, technical data, and software necessary for operation. Vendors are expected to provide staff training and regular system maintenance support. Vendors must obtain all required Federal, State, and Local certifications, licenses, and permits.
